This Awareness day will give us an opportunity as an Archdiocese to address the harmfulness of pornography in marriages, families, and our culture, while providing helpful resources to both individuals and families. It is an occasion for us to take a proactive approach in equipping parents, so they may better protect and safeguard their homes. **Safe Haven Sunday** is inspired by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' (USCCB) formal statement "Create in Me a Clean Heart: A Pastoral Response to Pornography." The statement explains, "The use of pornography by anyone in the home deprives the home of its role as a safe haven and has negative effects throughout a family's life and across generations."
